Mr. Maloney is in his 18th year as Director of Public Works for the City of Shoreview. He has, since 1994, directed all public infrastructure planning, design, construction and maintenance functions for the City. His 28 person department is responsible for the delivery of drinking water, sanitary sewer, street lighting and surface water management services, as well as the oversight of residential street reconstruction, curbside recycling, fleet management and urban forestry programs. Mark is responsible for the development and management of an annual budget which averages \$13 Million for construction and operational activities. The City's Public Works Department is recognized for leadership and innovation, and its operation and capital project activities are rated high in community surveys.

Mr. Maloney earned a Bachelor of Civil Engineering Degree from the University of Minnesota, and been a licensed Professional Engineer in Minnesota for 24 years. He served for 12 years on the Minnesota Local Road Board's Research Implementation Committee and continues to serve on the Transportation Engineering and Road Research Alliance (TERRA). Mark was recently appointed to the University of Minnesota Transportation Infrastructure Research Council, and in 2009 he was the first City Engineer to be recognized by the Transportation Research Community in Minnesota with the Rohrbach Distinguished Service Award. He was named the 2009 Engineer of the Year by the City Engineers Association of Minnesota. Mark is a Past President of the Minnesota Chapter of American Public Association, and he was named APWA Professional Manager of the Year for the category of Engineering and Technology for 2011.
